## The Beginnings-

In 1968 Jean Vanier agreed to give a retreat in Toronto, but insisted that it be open to all people: rich and poor, young and old, married and single. He especially wanted to welcome an array of abilities. Jean believed in creating a community in retreat by inviting people to share from their hearts. And so, Faith and Sharing was born.

In 1969, Father Jim O'Donnell went to Canada to participate in the second Faith and Sharing Retreat. It changed his life. Three years later, Jean Vanier and Fr. Jim inaugurated the retreat in Cleveland.

## What is Faith and Sharing?

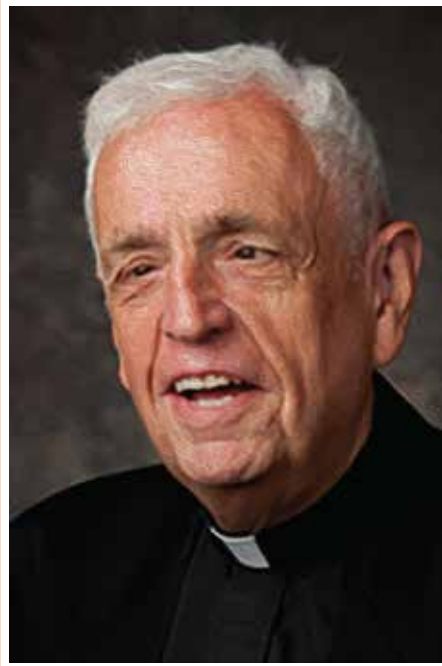
Faith and Sharing is an encounter with the Body of Christ in all its many gifts, dreams, and abilities. Faith and Sharing is a community with whom you can explore the invitation of the Gospel. It begins with a four-day experience, but it grows into a way of life.

## The Weekend

"Let nothing be wasted" is a theme born of a long distance conversation between Fr. Gillick and the planning team. At the end of the scene in John 6 it reads: "Everyone ate and was satisfied." Still, Jesus asked that the leftovers be gathered up. When fragments were collected after thousands were fed, there were more than the five loaves and two fish provided by the child at the start. God's love is abundant. "Let nothing be wasted."

## The Animator • Fr. Larry Gillick, S.J.

Fr. Gillick was born in Milwaukee and attended Marquette Jesuit High and St. Norbert College before entering the Society of Jesus in 1960. He received his bachelor's degree from St. Louis University in 1966. He taught at Campion Jesuit High in Wisconsin for the next three years. He was ordained in June 1972 after completing his theology studies at Regis College in Toronto. For the next seven years, he was on the staff of the seminary in Toronto as a Spiritual Director for the younger Jesuits.

He was sent to Omaha in 1979 as Spiritual Director for the young Scholastics studying at Creighton University and living at Campion House in Omaha. In 1984, he assumed the office of Rector of the Jesuit Community at Creighton Prep in Omaha. He served in this capacity until the fall of 1991, when he was assigned to be the Director of the Deglman Center for Ignatian Spirituality at Creighton University.

Father Gillick presently occupies his time offering spiritual direction to students, faculty and alumni of Creighton University as well as directing retreats and days of reflection around the country.
