Father Dan Schlegel was born in Lakewood and raised in Bay Village, OH. He attended St. Raphael Elementary School, St. Ignatius High School, Bonomeo College of Ohio, and Saint Mary Seminary. Father Dan was ordained a diocesan priest on May 28, 1988. He was actively involved in all aspects of parish ministry as an associate pastor at St. Leo the Great Parish, Cleveland (1988-94), associate pastor at Holy Cross Parish, Euclid (1994-99), associate pastor at St. Christopher Parish, Rocky River (1999-2002) and pastor of Holy Angels Parish in Bainbridge Township Ohio (2002-2018). In January of 2019 Fr. Schlegel assumed a new position in the Diocese of Cleveland as the Vicar and Secretary for Clergy and Religious. In addition to his parish assignment, he served as diocesan moderator for Retrouvaille, a program for couples in troubled marriages from 1995-2018.

History of Faith and Sharing

In 1968, Jean Vanier, a former philosophy teacher at St. Michael's University in Toronto, was invited by the Bishop to give a retreat for priests. At that time, Jean Vanier was living in France where he founded the L'Arche Community.

Jean Vanier agreed to give the retreat, but insisted that it not be a retreat solely for priests. He asked it be open to all people from many walks of life, and in 1968, Faith and Sharing was born and soon became a worldwide movement. He invited people to share from their hearts. In 1969, Fr. Jim O'Donnell attended the second Faith and Sharing Retreat in Canada. Fr. believed this retreat changed his life and committed his priesthood to being present to the poor and marginalized.
